Resolution 2020-05 Grand Trustees By-Laws (Requires a 2/3 majority for approval)

SYNOPSIS: This legislation requires of the Grand Lodge Secretary to make available upon request a copy of the By-Laws of the Grand Trustees.

WHEREAS, this legislation brings light to the rules under which the Grand Lodge Board of Trustees operates for the education of the Craft, and

WHEREAS, light is what we promise to our candidates and provide to our membership, and

WHEREAS, Master Masons are on the level, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Grand Lodge Board of Trustees By-Laws shall be made available by amending Section 14-301(c) of the Arizona Masonic Statutes as follows (Additions in **Bold Type**, there are no deletions):

Section 14-301 – Grand Trustees (Powers, Duties, Removal). The Grand Trustees shall be elected as prescribed in the Constitution.

- (a) (Remains the same)
- (b) (Remains the same)
- (c) The Board of Trustees shall have power to adopt By-Laws for their own guidance and for the management of the property and business affairs of the Grand Lodge over which they have control and may amend such By-Laws at any time. They shall also have power to adopt and enforce such rules and regulations, not inconsistent with the Constitution or Statutes, as they may find needful or proper for the handling and management of the property and business affairs committed to them by the Constitution. A current copy of the Board of Trustees By-Laws shall be held by the Grand Lodge Secretary and made available upon request to any Arizona Master Mason who hold a current dues card.
